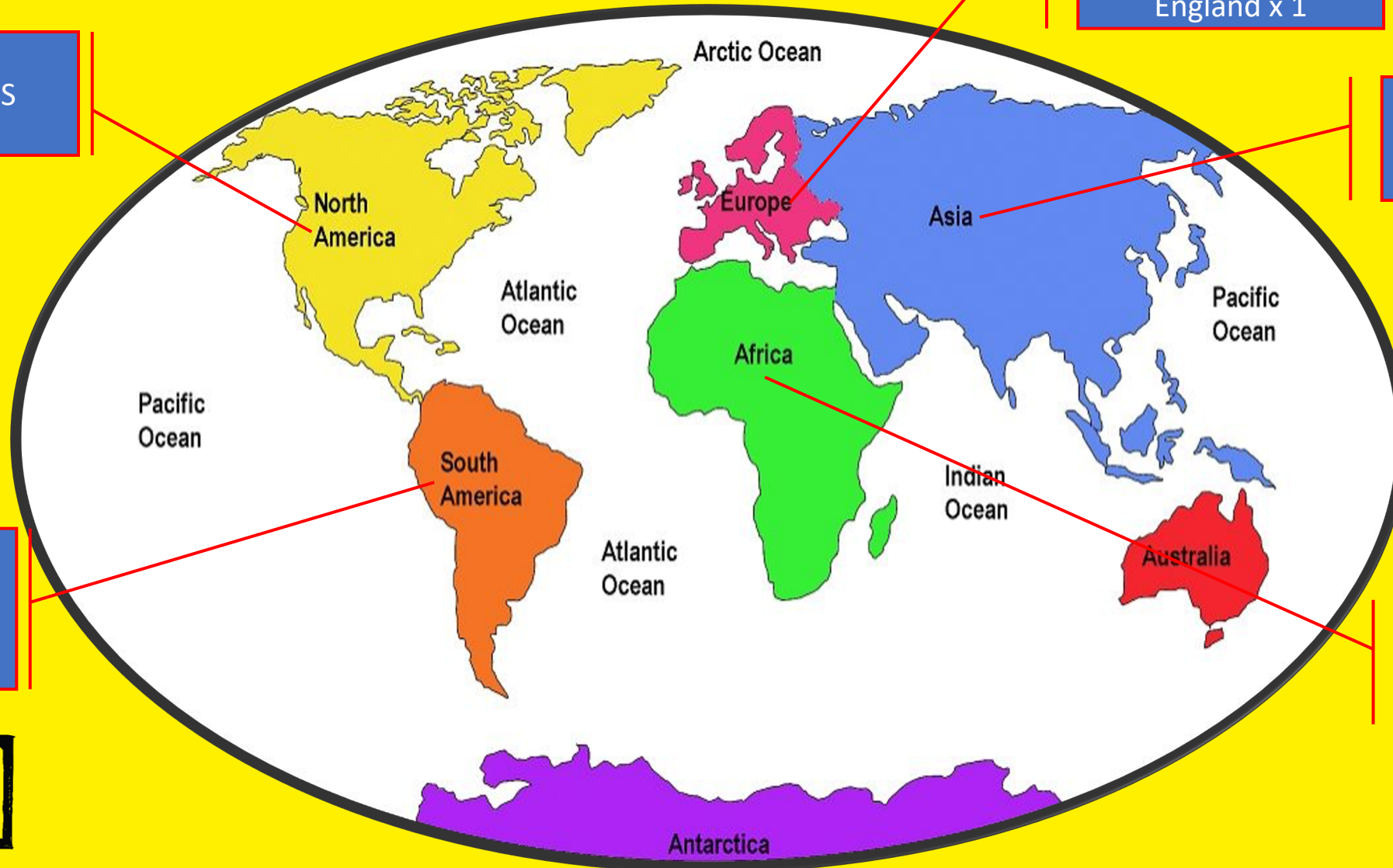

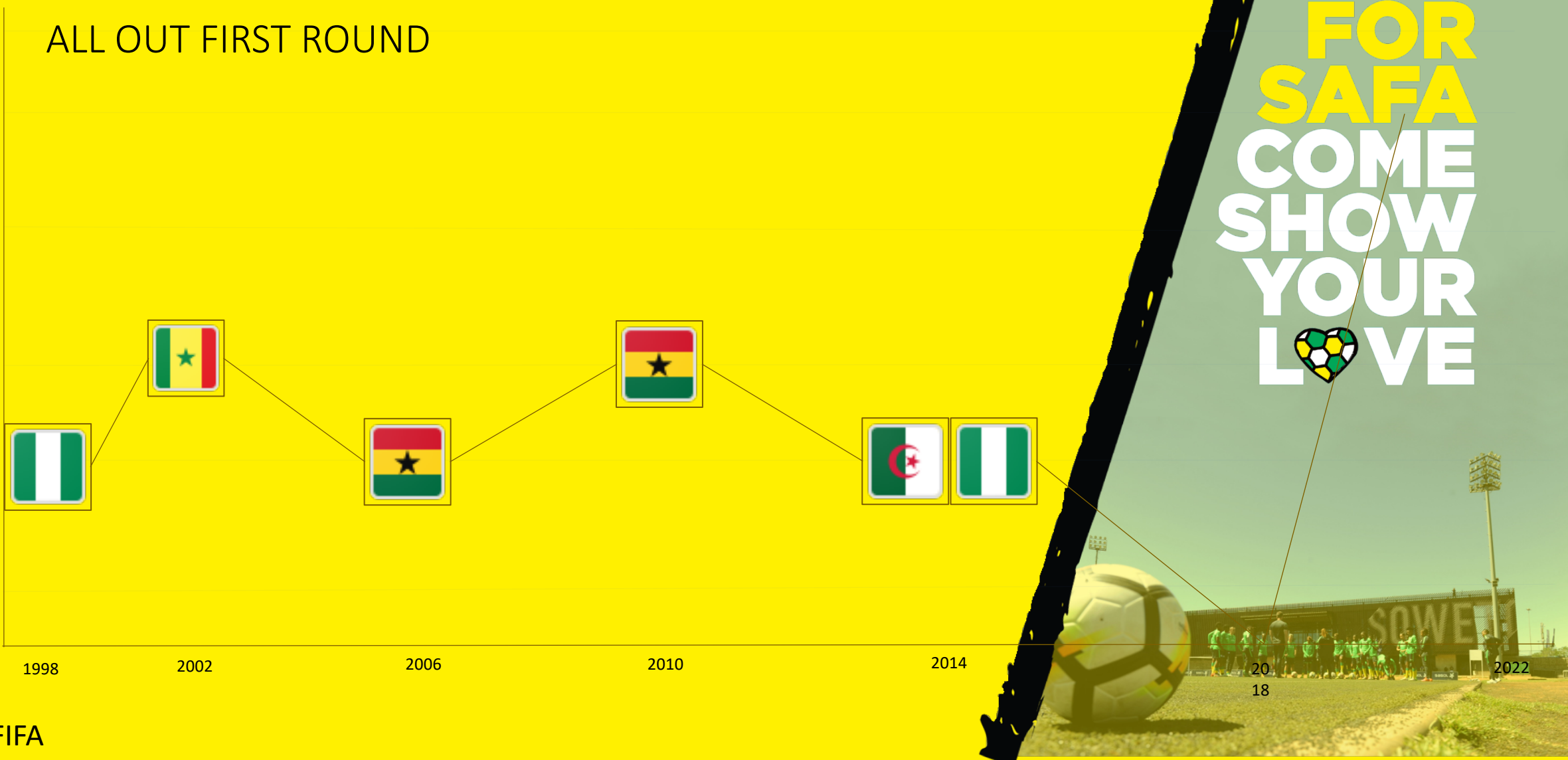

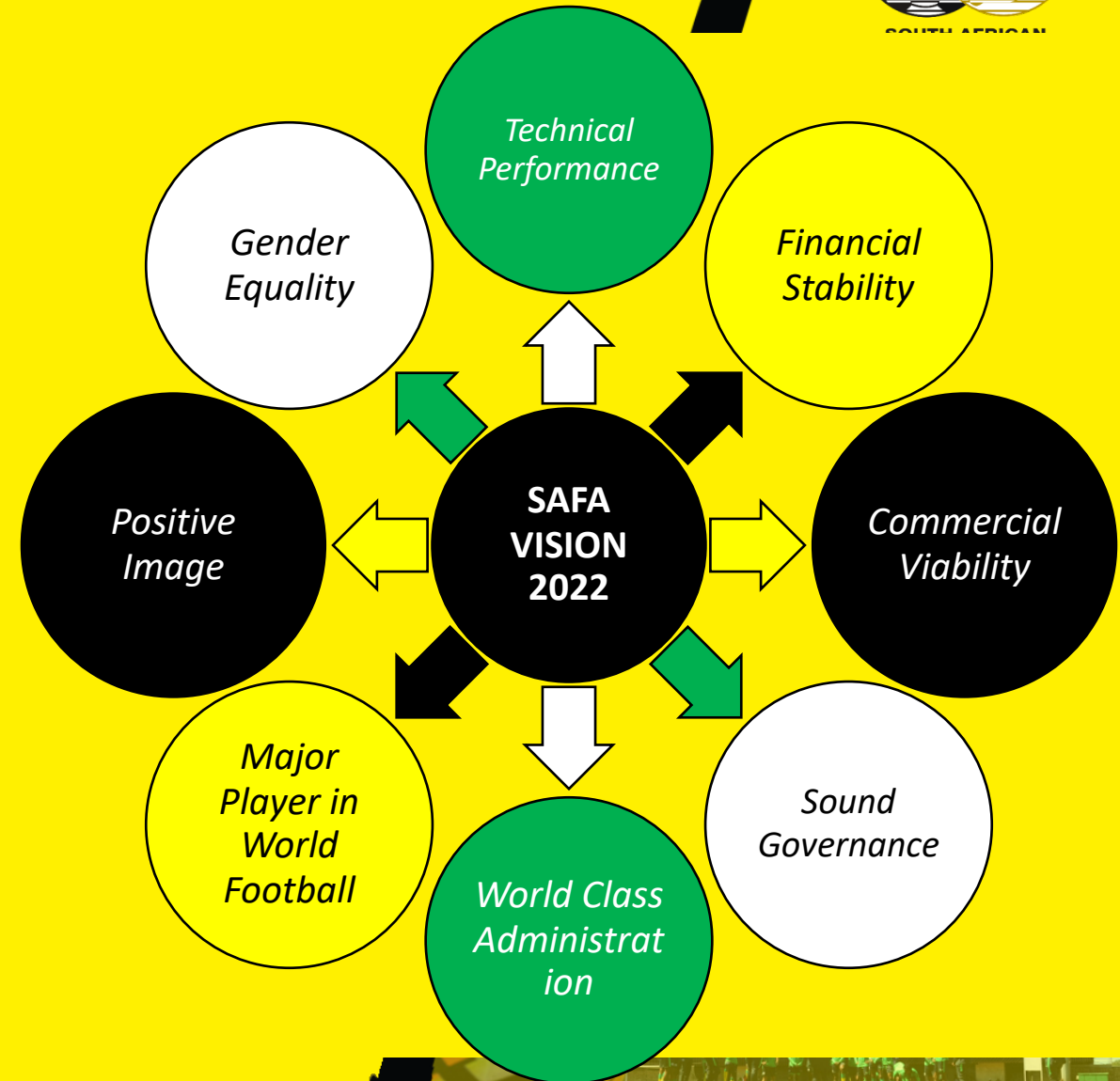

GOVERNANCE

SAFA governance the association's statutes are align to the FIFA statutes and endorsed by FIFA.

- 1) The **National Executive Committee** led by the President has a four-year term and is elected by members at the ordinary congress.
- 2) The NEC accounts to the members at the ordinary congress via various governance committees and
- 3) an independent ETHICS COMMITTEE WITH TWO SUPREME COURT JUDGES AS MEMBERS
- 4) AND AN INDEPENDENT INTEGRITY OFFICER.
- 5) **SAFA statutes** prescribe that at all levels one of the vice-presidents must be a women and at least one other women must form part of the executive, but NEC must be **minimum 4 women**.

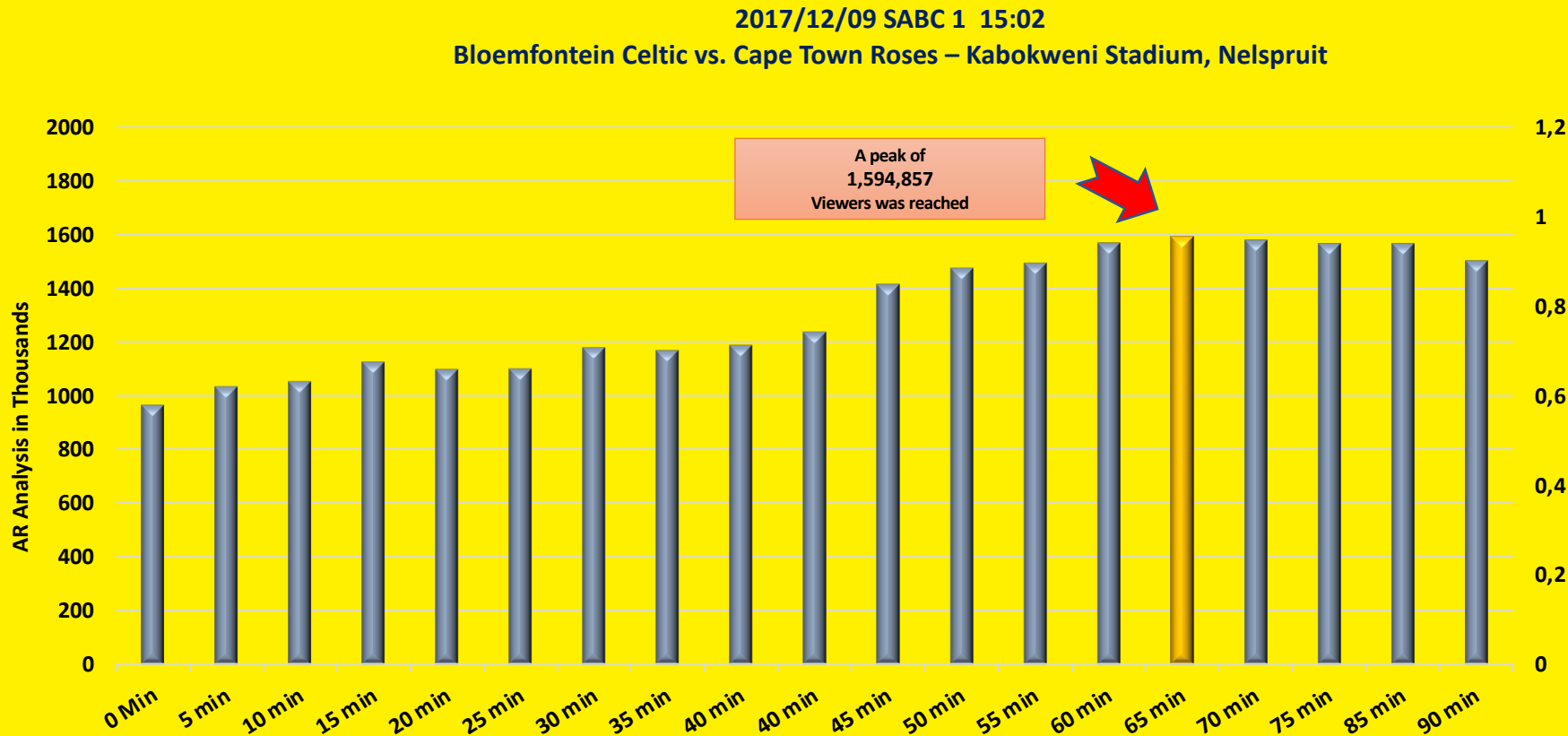

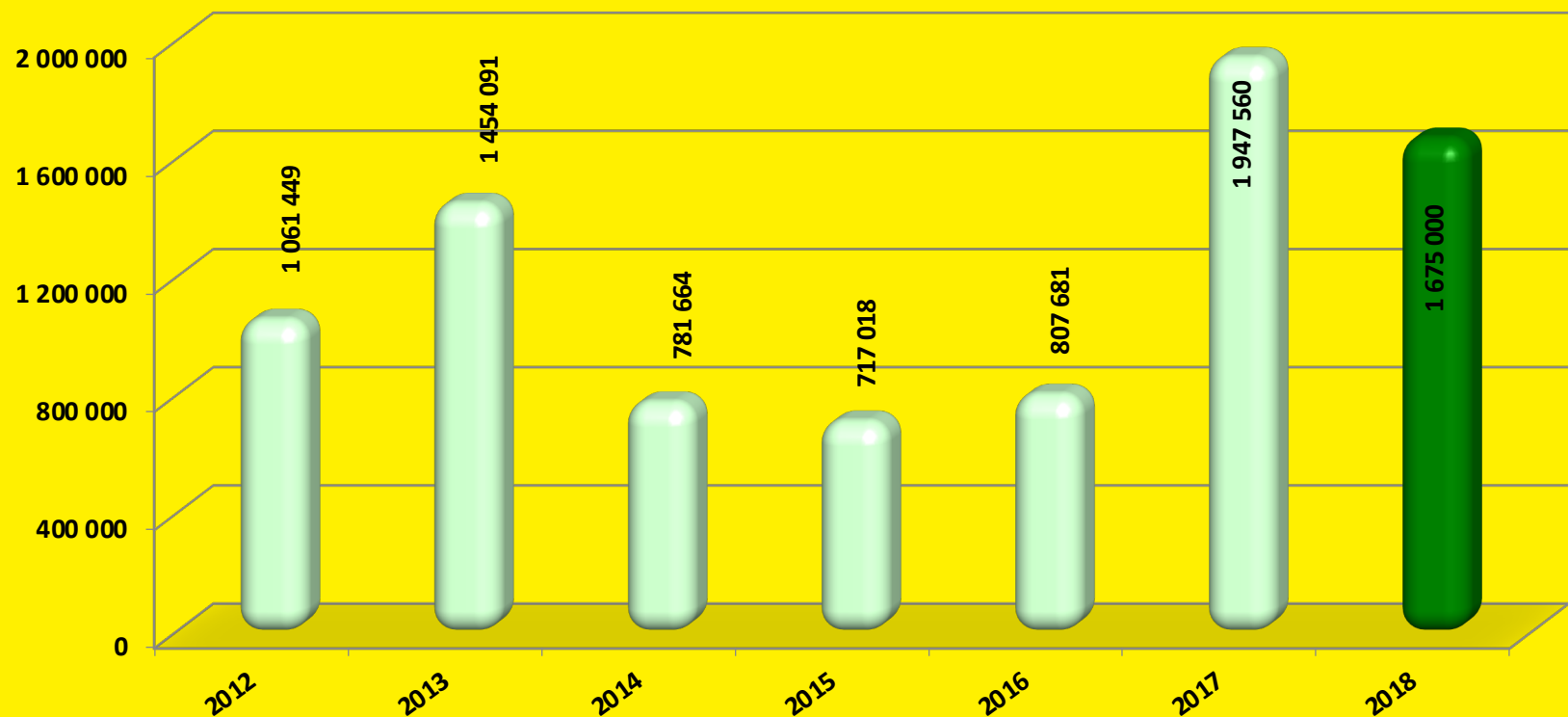
