

A survey was sent to the regions and provinces in the past to track and trace the coaches who were trained by the Association.

The survey intends to achieve the following:

- 1. Gain understanding of the work (coaching) environment of the coaches in the country.
- 2. Tap in their experiences to influence the current coaching content and methodology.
- 3. Assist the Coaching Education Department to identify any coaching gaps, the efficacy of the curriculum and design the relevant intervention
- 4. Provide further workplace support where the need arises.
- 5. Invite the coaches for further training in line with the various Memoranda of Understanding the Association has with various MAs and partners
- 6. Establish an engaged community of coaches

While we received appreciable responses, it has been realised that a large number of coaches did not respond to the survey. As a result, we have many coaches who are not accounted for and this raises serious concerns about the continued training of coaches without having a clear record of their work and its impact in the development of the game in South Africa in line with the goal of Vision 2022.
